- Knowledge of and experience in effective classroom management, student-centered learning, and cooperative instructional strategies
- Ability to effectively communicate orally and in writing to students, parents, administration, teachers and the community in a professional manner
- Possess a valid State of Hawaii Teaching License in visual arts

- Experience teaching heterogeneously grouped classes
